## What the author gets

... is always **40%** of the net proceeds.

These are our conditions:

- Soon after each issue was published deinblick editors decide which contributions will be provided within the download zone and put them online.
- The number of contents provided will be limited to the best contributions representing pure life. These files are only meant for private use such as posters, printings etc. Any commercial usage is strictly prohibited (please see our terms and conditions).
- deinblick decides about the pricing, which depends upon the kind of content and its former upload quality (please see the chart above).
- At the beginning of each month we sum up the proceeds from your contributions. Your personal settlement will be sent via email soon after, providing an overview about how often your contribution was downloaded as well as your current credit status.
- We'll ask you for your bank account to transfer your total credit once your account either reaches 100€ or half a year has passed from the day your contribution was published in our download zone.
- We can send you the money via bank transfer, or via PayPal.
- Note that if you live outside the Euro Zone we can still send your money via bank transfer, but you will be responsible for any and all additional fees and/or charges (these costs vary from bank to bank). PayPal offers a money-sending-service and the fees are much lower, and that's why we recommend setting up a PayPal transaction for non-EU contributors. - Along with that we will automatically transfer all related taxes to the German finance authority.
